Signs of Child Sexual Abuse

- Difficulty walking or sitting
- Scratching themselves in their private areas or frequently touching themselves in their private areas
- Touching others in their genital area
- Complaining of pain or itching in the genital area
- Pain when going to the bathroom
- Discharge or foul smell in the private area
- Torn, stained or bloody underclothing or bloody stains in the under clothing
- Frequent complaints of stomach aches or headaches
- Bruises or bleeding in the genital area
- Genital marks or bruises
- Feeling threatened with physical contact
- Afraid to go to bathroom, holding urine and bowel movements
- Playing with feces or having accidents in their pants
- Inappropriate sexual play, sexual talk or premature understanding of sex
- Frequent yeast infections or urinary infections, symptoms of sexual diseases, venereal warts
